Pete Lawrence, who is currently Head of BBC Features Production, will join Tigress as Creative Director at the start of 2014.

Pete is a leading programme maker with over 25 years' experience in creating and producing formats, factual entertainment and documentary films.

As Head of BBC Features Production, he is responsible for overseeing and driving the development of an extensive slate including long running hits such as 'Watchdog', 'Crimewatch', 'Antiques Roadshow', 'Gardeners World' and 'Countryfile'.

In the food genre, Pete brought Nigel Slater to BBC One ('Simple Suppers', 'Dish of the Day'), and has worked with the country's finest chefs and food writers, including Nigella Lawson, Rachel Khoo, Michel Roux, James Martin and Lorraine Pascale.

In documentaries, Pete has delivered ratings winners including 'The Prison Restaurant', 'John Bishop's Sport Relief Hell', 'The Red Nose Desert Trek', and 'Million Pound Bike Ride'. He has also Executive Produced hit formats such as 'DIY SOS' and 'Wanted Down Under' as well as the appeal films for both Comic and Sport Relief.

Since joining the BBC in 2001 Pete's numerous senior roles have included Head of Development, BBC Bristol Factual and Creative Director, Features. He has also Series Produced a diverse portfolio including 'Holiday Swaps' on BBC One and 'Timeshift' on BBC Four.

Claire Urquhart has joined Tigress as Head of Development. Claire had previously been Head of BBC Features Development, Pan UK, since October 2012, during which time her credits included 'Hairy Bikers Asian Odyssey' (BBC Two) and 'The Great British Winter' (BBC Daytime). Her earlier credits as Head of Features & BBC Three Development at BBC Bristol include: 'Supermarket Farm' with Nigel Slater and Adam Henson (BBC One); 'Cash Britain' (BBC One), 'Hairy Bikers: Everyday Gourmet' (BBC Two), 'Lorraine Pascal Fast, Fresh, Easy' (BBC Two), 'Nigelissima' (BBC Two), 'Nigel Slater's Rules of Attraction' (BBC One) and 'Antiques Rescue Squad' (BBC Two).

Prior to this Claire was at Outline Productions where formats she developed included 'The Great British Food Revival '(BBC Daytime), 'The Secret Tourist' (BBC1) and 'Fat Families' (Sky One). Her extensive experience in development has also included roles such as Development Producer, Diverse Bristol and Senior Development Producer, BBC Features & Formats.

Productions in 2013 include the ground-breaking three part TV event, *Africa 2013: Countdown to the Rains*, which has just completed its run on BBC Two; *Naked and Marooned* (Discovery); *Edward VIII: The Lion King* (Channel 4); *Nature Shock* (Channel 5); *Winter Viruses and How to Beat Them* (BBC Two) and programming for *The One Show* (BBC One).
